DESCRIPTION: Last year, the Pyramid Model was adopted by the State of New Hampshire as the evidence-based multi-tiered framework designed to build social competence and help preschool children prepare for schooling. This presentation will address practical Pyramid Model strategies for promoting social competence in early childhood using features associated with building supportive relationships, structuring the classroom environment, and addressing behaviors of concern. **Participants will learn prevention strategies for creating core values, a classroom theme, and behavioral expectations** for important routines as well as ideas for teaching and celebrating success. Response strategies will include the use of corrective teacher language, the Basic Rs of responding, logical consequences, and a problem-solving technique. Examples from NH Early Childhood programs will be provided.
