Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events (CRASE) Training will **help you to quickly decide to take action by providing a strategy that develops your situational awareness, mental planning and a common sense approach to surviving an active shooter event.** CRASE is a U.S. Department of Justice sanctioned training course developed by Texas State University.
