

2022 Training & TA Institute: Transformational Coaching to Promote Continuous Quality Improvement

The purpose of this training is to use transformational coaching for coaches to consistently focus on how to support early care professionals to get better at getting better, and to reframe our focus from “Ratings” (QRIS) to “Continuous Quality” (CQI) to achieve “sticky change”.

- Shift mindset and behaviors from being a content expert to a change agent facilitating the change process that promotes CQI
- Cultivate the essential qualities of change that promote sustainable change
- Differentiate the continuum of professional development strategies
