

Pyramid Model Readiness Training: Is Your Community Ready?

The Pyramid Model for Supporting Social Emotional Competence in Infants and Young Children is a conceptual framework of evidence-based practices that has been implemented in early childhood programs across the nation. In 2016 NH became the 28th Pyramid Model State, embarking on a cross-sector, multi-year commitment to improving the social-emotional competence of children, birth through five in our state. This training is for participants who are interested in learning more about the model with consideration for implementation within their community. Participants will explore each

layer of the Pyramid Model to get a glimpse of the practices and systemic supports that can be embedded into programming to provide higher quality early childhood environments for children as well as higher levels of support to teachers. The day will wrap up with a reflective activity where participants will investigate their community's readiness to implement the Pyramid Model to fidelity.

Presenter:

Aimee Newswanger joins us from Lancaster, Pennsylvania where she serves as an Early Intervention Technical Assistance Consultant and sits on the State Early Childhood PBIS sub-committee as its Central Regional Facilitator. In this capacity she supports state and local programs in the implementation of Pyramid Model practices.
