

T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® NH Scholarship Information Sessions On CDA Scholarships



The T.E.A.C.H. (Teacher Education and Compensation Helps) Early Childhood® (T.E.A.C.H.) Initiative is a national, evidence-based strategy that **creates access to higher education** for teachers, directors and family child care providers working with young children in out-of-home settings. T.E.A.C.H. provides comprehensive scholarships to enable these early educators to take coursework **leading to a CDA credential** and degree by making it possible for them to afford both the time and expense of going to school. **Recipients complete CDA training hours** or enroll in courses at local colleges while working at least 30 hours per week.



Recipients also agree to remain at sponsoring center for at least six (6) months following the completion of their scholarship contract. One of the four T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® New Hampshire's **scholarship options is helping professionals obtain their CDA credential**. In each information session, we will explain how to obtain a CDA credential, discuss this initiative and what T.E.A.C.H. NH has to offer to NH Providers.
