Tick-Safe Strategies

The goal of this training is to teach individuals how to identify and adopt evidence-based tick-safe prevention strategies to enhance their health and safety and avoid disease. By the end of the session you will be able to identify: ticks that transmit pathogens in NH, explain where and when you would expect to find ticks in NH, describe how to manage outdoor spaces to make them less attractive to ticks, describe how to protect yourself from being bitten by a tick and describe how to check for ticks and what to do if you find an attached tick.
