# Early Childhood Tuition Assistance Grant

## Apply to Receive Tuition Assistance

Funded by the NH Child Development Bureau, the Early Childhood Tuition Assistance (ECTA) Grant at Granite State College is applicable to one course per term.

### Do I Qualify?

This grant is available to teachers working a minimum of 20 hours per week in a NH licensed center, and directors working a minimum of 30 hours per week in a NH licensed center.

### Important Information Regarding the ECTA Grant

Applications will be reviewed as received. Applications fill fast so apply early. Money is awarded at 100% tuition for your first Early Childhood Education course (PSY 508 Child Development), EDU 602, EDU 544 or PSY 510 or 50% tuition for subsequent Early Childhood Education courses. Students are responsible for all materials needed for the course and the \$85 registration fee.

Awarded money will be removed from a student's account and they will be billed for the total cost of the course for the following reasons:

- Students withdraw from the course after the add/drop period
- Students do not participate in the course after registering
- Students stop participating in the course after registering
- Students do not receive a passing grade in the course
