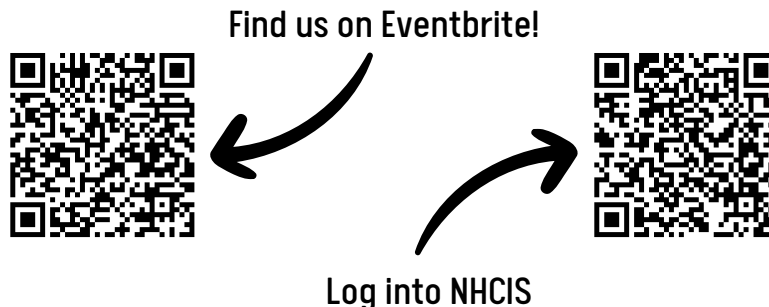


Hello and Welcome!
