### Paul Deignan, MSW

 For ten years, Paul Deignan served as the State of New Hampshire Disaster Behavioral Health Coordinator. He served in that capacity out of the NH Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and the Department of Health and Human Services. He holds a Master's Degree in Social Work from the Boston College School of Social Work with a concentration in Community Organization and Social Planning. Paul has provided training in the areas of Psychological First Aid, Critical Incident Stress Management, Responding to Critical Incidents in Schools, Suicide Postvention, Community Resiliency, Substance Use and Abuse in Disasters and Compassion Fatigue.

### John Watkins, FEMA Educational & Training Officer

John retired from Raytheon IT in 2014 after 37 years of service. He is a Navy veteran. Nowadays he spends his time teaching (predominantly seniors). He teaches “computers”, Disaster Preparedness, and Cyber Security. John is certified by FEMA/EMI to teach disaster preparedness. He also teaches a FEMA class entitled “Until Help Arrives”. He is qualified to train other instructors in these courses. John is certified by the Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training organization to teach Civilian Response to an Active Shooter Event. John has been a member of the Greater Nashua Community Emergency Response Team for 6 years and is currently the Education/Training officer. He will be starting his 6th year as a facilitator for Rivier University’s Institute for Senior Education.
