Individual Challenge

To meet the Early Childhood Credentialing Challenge individuals must:

- Complete the Individual Credentialing Challenge Application Form & Release.
- Receive any one of the following types of Technical Assistance from CCAoNH:
 - Onsite Technical Assistance
 - Phone Technical Assistance
 - Training Resources to Support Credentialing Application Process (NH Professional Registry, Teacher Competencies, Credentialing)
- Be enrolled in the NH Professional Registry with completed education and employment records.
- Apply for an Early Childhood Credential by March 1, 2019.
- Receive their credential at the Celebration of Early Childhood Professionals on Tuesday, April 30, 2019 at Grace Capital Church in Pembroke, NH.

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Team Challenge

To meet the Early Childhood Credentialing Team Challenge programs must:

- Complete and submit a Credentialing Team Challenge Commitment Form & Release.
 - Have the Director and 40% of staff receive either a new credential or renew their credential
- Have each staff member receive any one of the following types of Technical Assistance from CCAoNH:
 - Onsite Technical Assistance
 - Phone Technical Assistance
 - Training Resources to Support Credentialing Application Process (NH Professional Registry, Teacher Competencies, Credentialing)
- Have all staff be enrolled in the NH Professional Registry with completed education and employment records.
- Have all participating team staff apply for an Early Childhood Credential by March 1, 2019.
- Have all participating team staff receive their credential at the Celebration of Early Childhood Professionals on Tuesday, April 30, 2019 at Grace Capital Church in Pembroke, NH.
