Maize USD 266 Parent as Teachers Starlets Policies

ENROLLMENT:

Enrollment and health information forms must be completed for each child and on file with the Maize Parents as Teachers office. Please contact us with any e-mail, address or contact information changes.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT:

All classes are designed for children accompanied by an adult to participate in a variety of activities. The child will benefit from the parent/guardian actively taking part with them.

ABSENCES:

We like to encourage regular attendance in classes. As they are sign-up and limited in number, please try to attend each class.

ILLNESS:

Participants should be free from any illness, fever or runny nose to attend playgroup. If under a doctor's care, antibiotics should have been administered for a minimum of 24 hours.

INCLEMENT WEATHER:

If Maize USD 266 is cancelling school, all PAT/STARLETS classes, special events and home visits will also be cancelled.

SIBLINGS:

Each Starlets class is designed to target specific age groups. As we cannot provide childcare, siblings may attend, however it is encouraged to bring only the child that is enrolled in the class in order for that child to best benefit from the parent's direct attention while participating in the appropriate age level of activities. Note: STARLETS may only bring siblings to classes designated for siblings.

BEHAVIOR:

Each child is expected to use proper behavior and should be monitored by the parent or guardian that is accompanying the child. This includes siblings attending class. Please be courteous of other participants and, if necessary, step out of the room to comfort your child. We hope to provide a positive environment in which all children feel safe and successful during the activities.

SUPPLIES:

Parents are asked to donate supplies for each class they are in.

SNACK:

Parents are asked to sign up for a day each semester to bring snack for their child's class. We suggest that parents bring a simple dry snack in a baggie or individual packaged snacks. Snack ideas will be given the first day of class.

FEEDBACK:

Participants are encouraged to share their observations, questions and reactions. Comments can be directed to the Parent Educator leading the group or the Program Coordinator.
