DESIGN AWARDS

- ☐ Open to AIASV Members. Entrant must be an AIASV member Licensed Architect.
- ☐ Projects must have been completed (Built) or designed (Project-in-Design) after January 1, 2015.
- ☐ Projects that have previously been awarded by the AIASV are not eligible. Projects that have been awarded by other chapters or organizations remain eligible.
- ☐ The Well Lived Award is for singling out a specific project that has withstood the test of time. These projects must be at least 20 years or older to be entered into this category.

DESIGN AWARDS OUT OF AREA ARCHITECT

- ☐ Open to outside of the area AIA members with work within the AIASV chapter area. Outside of the Area Architect must be an AIA member Licensed Architect.
- ☐ Building Projects must be located within AIASV Chapter Area and have been completed (Built) after January 1, 2015.
- ☐ Projects that have previously been awarded by the AIASV are not eligible. Projects that have been awarded by other chapters or organizations remain eligible.

EMERGING PROFESSIONAL

- ☐ Open AIASV Members who have been licensed in the last 10 years, and who are responsible for the design of the project being submitted. Entrant must be an AIASV member Licensed Architect.
- ☐ Projects must have been completed (Built) or designed (Project-in-Design) after January 1, 2015.
- ☐ Projects that have previously been awarded by the AIASV are not eligible. Projects that have been awarded by other chapters or organizations remain eligible.
- ☐ The award submission guidelines will follow and adapt to the AIA Emerging Professional guidelines, but be limited to licensed AIASV members. For the AIA guidelines, visit <https://www.aia.org/pages/11531-award-submissions>

CRAFTSMANSHIP AWARDS

- ☐ Open to AIASV members, or Contractors who have worked on AIASV member projects, can submit for the Craftsmanship Award.
- ☐ The work can be located anywhere.
- ☐ This award is a broad category, where the jurors will be looking for that 'divine detail' on project that demonstrates the competency of the Architect and the execution by the Contractor(s).
- ☐ This award is open for any detail that may involve woodworking, concrete, ironwork, brick, flooring, wall or ceiling conditions than demonstrates excellence in both detailing and construction. Integrated art work and sculpture is also acceptable.
- ☐ This award is open for projects completed in the last ten (10) years.
- ☐ The craftsmanship award submittal shall include the Architects concept detail and/or construction detail, along with a photograph(s) of the constructed condition.

INTERIORS AWARD

- ☐ Open to AIASV Members / ASID / IIDA members with work within this AIASV chapter area.
- ☐ This award is open for any project that demonstrates excellence in the art of Interior Architecture and/or Interior Design.
- ☐ This award is for projects considered as 'interiors only', and not a part of an overall project being submitted with the Design Awards.
- ☐ This award is open for projects completed in the last ten (10) years.

LIFE-TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

- ☐ Open to AIASV Members. Entrant must be an AIASV member Licensed Architect.
- ☐ Nominees for this award should be selected for their contribution to the built environment, community, and the profession of architecture

COMMUNITY SERVICE

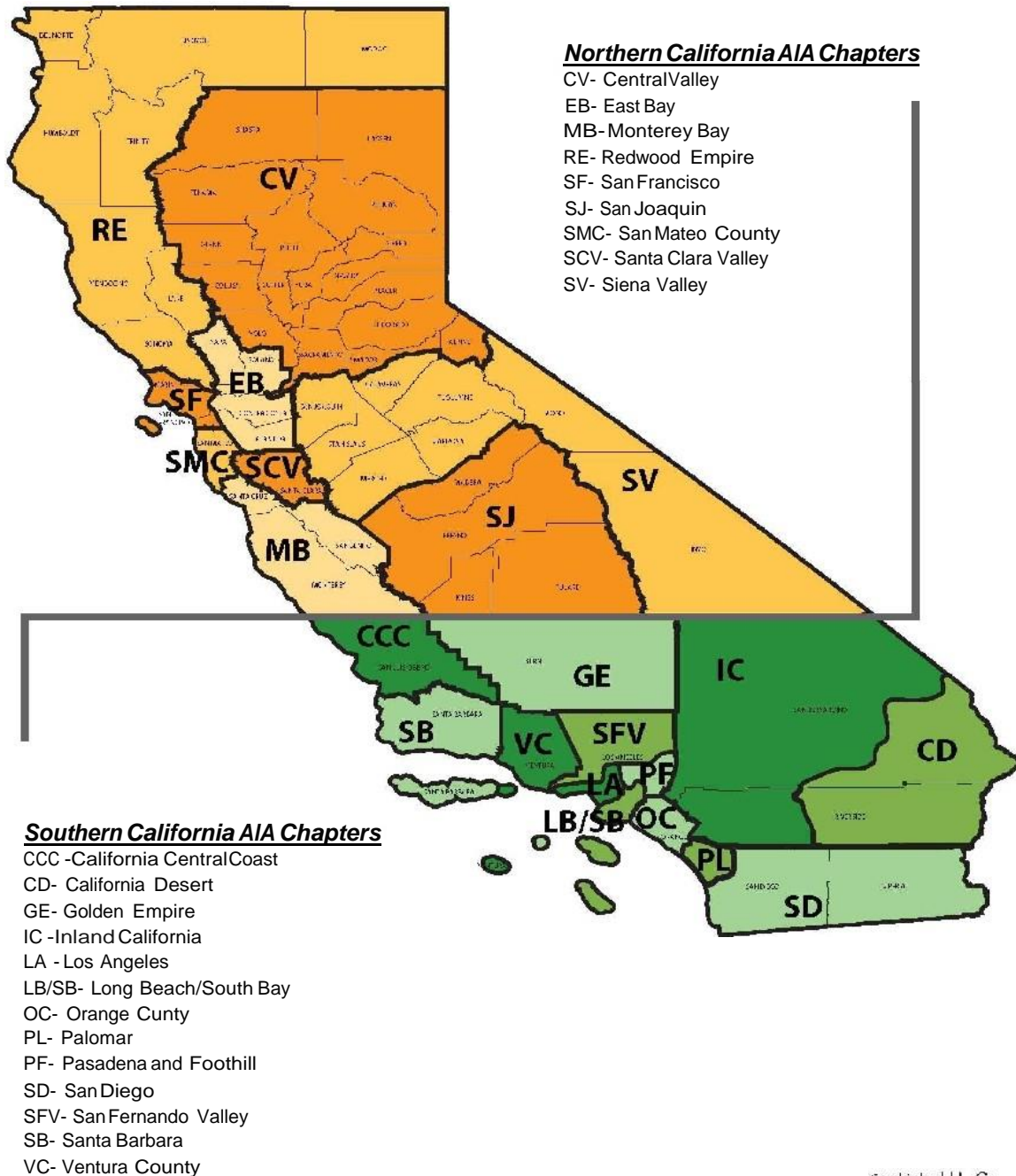
- ☐ Open to AIASV Members. Entrant must be an AIASV member Licensed Architect.
