Marriage Story is a 2019 American comedy-drama film written and directed by Noah Baumbach. The film stars Scarlett Johansson, Adam Driver, Laura Dern, Alan Alda, Ray Liotta, Azhy Robertson, Julie Hagerty, Matthew Shear and Merritt Wever, following a married couple going through a coast-to-coast divorce. It had its world premiere at Venice Film Festival on August 29, 2019, and began a limited theatrical release on November 6, 2019, to be followed by digital streaming on December 6, 2019, by Netflix. The film received critical acclaim, particularly for Baumbach's screenplay and direction, as well as its acting (particularly that of Johansson, Driver, and Dern), and musical score. **(NETFLIX STREAMING)**
