The annual Southern Classic livestock show brought us to the holiday season and the finish to another great year of events at the Expo.

The Expo Exhibit Hall/Ballrooms were host to the Antique Show and Southwest Electrical Meter Assn. in October bringing out-of-town guests for extended stays. The Education Career Fair, Ducks Unlimited Banquet, Agrilife Banquet, and the ever-popular and growing Chamber Ag Breakfast brought local producers and businesses together at the perfect time to celebrate the local producers and give thanks for our many blessings during the Thanksgiving holidays. The holiday season was on display with several Christmas festivities to bring 2019 to a close.

It is hard to believe we are in 2020 now and our busy schedule has begun with every weekend in January booked with multiple events.
