The workshops will provide participants with the opportunity to learn more about the Aquaculture Opportunity Area process, share the soon to be published NCCOS Gulf of Alaska Aquaculture Opportunity Atlas (Atlas), and offer input on developing an Alaska aquaculture mapping and permitting tool.
