


Dear Queen of the Rosary Parish Family,

I write to inform you that the Archdiocese has received an allegation of sexual misconduct with an adult against Deacon Keith Strohm who served in your parish from May 2015 until July 2019. In keeping with Archdiocese policy, I have removed Deacon Strohm's faculties to minister while the allegation is investigated.

The Archdiocese of Chicago takes seriously its obligation to ensure the fitness for ministry of all who serve the People of God. We encourage anyone who feels they have been sexually abused by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee to come forward. Complete information about reporting sexual abuse can be found on the Archdiocesan website at www.archchicago.org.

I will keep you in prayer and will communicate developments in this matter as information becomes available.

A note from Fr. Dan:

I know it is difficult to hear this kind of news. We should keep all involved in this situation in prayer. There may be questions about the details of this allegation—what happened, when or where it may have occurred—but I do not have any information other than what the Cardinal has sent.

Deacon Strohm has had his faculties (in other words, his permission) for the public exercise of ministry temporarily removed pending the outcome of this investigation. A precautionary removal of faculties is a step to protect all parties, and should not be viewed as an assertion of guilt. Deacon Strohm is entitled to a presumption of innocence at this time.

At the same time, I want to reiterate that I take all matters of misconduct and abuse very seriously. Your first step should always be to report any such incidents to the police and civil authorities.




Tuesday Morning Scripture Discussion




