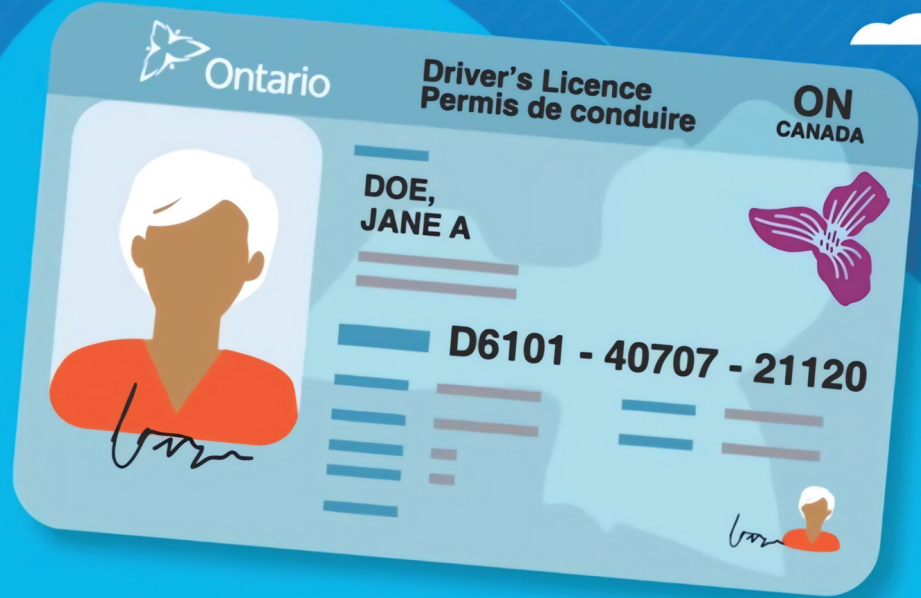

## Over 80 Renewal Program

- Drivers must renew their licence every two years starting at age 80.
- Renewal notice is mailed 90 days prior to licence expiry.
- Renewal process includes mandatory vision and cognitive screening assessments in one visit at ServiceOntario.

### After the Assessment

Depending on your results, you may be able to renew your licence or you may need to complete one or more of the following:

- Pass a road test.
- Follow-up with your doctor and submit medical information.
- If additional medical information is required, you will be notified by mail.
- Provide additional vision information from a doctor or optometrist.
- Once requirements are completed successfully, renew your driver's licence by paying the renewal fee.

## Safe Driving Practices

- Get regular eye examinations.
- Stretch and exercise to stay flexible.
- Check mirrors often and stay aware.
- Park in a way that allows you to drive straight out of a parking space.
- Keep a safe following distance.
- Make three right turns to avoid a left turn.
- Avoid distractions (passengers, radio, phone).
- Don't drive when upset, tired, or anxious.
- Plan your route to avoid heavy traffic.

### Did You Know?

- You may renew your driver's licence up to 180 days before it expires.
- No vision screening is needed at your appointment if you bring a vision report from an eye doctor with confirmed results. It must:
  - be signed/dated within the last 6 months
  - contain a measurement for acuity and peripheral
- If you no longer wish to drive, consider applying for the Ontario Photo Card.
