This week-long course combines two core NATMI programs, *Motor Fleet Safety Basics* and *Managing Motor Fleet Safety Programs*, adapted specifically for the Canadian transportation environment.

Participants will explore how to design, implement, and manage effective fleet safety programs under Canadian federal and provincial legislation. Topics include:

- ESDC and provincial labour requirements
- Record-keeping and compliance with MTO and NSC standards
- Collision reporting and analysis
- Injury prevention and early-return-to-work programs
- Driver hiring, retention, and performance management
- Building and sustaining a proactive safety culture
