- Hebrew: we concluded studying Megillat Esther and watched an Israeli musical telling the story. All in Hebrew.

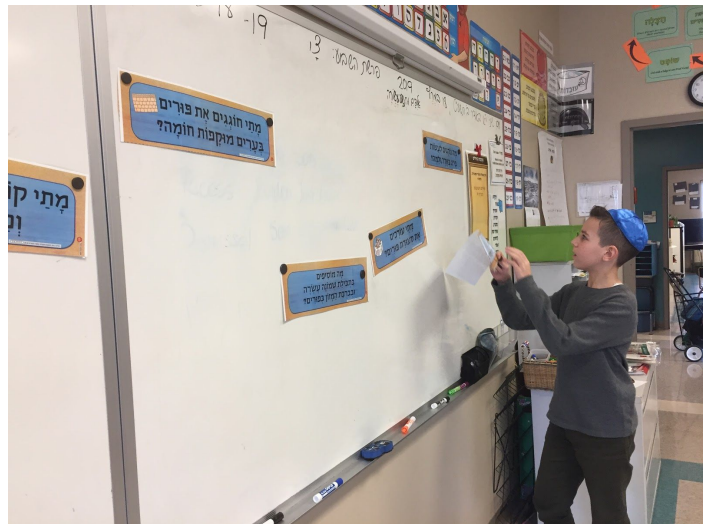
