We had a wonderful week of school! Some things we did this week were:

- Science-Introduction to habitats
- English-finished our student interviews, reviewed letters: x, w, v
- Math-practiced number formation and addition
- Buddies-made *sukkah* decorations with our buddies
- Hebrew-learned the letter *vet*
- Judaics-learned about *Yom Kippur* (read stories about saying sorry for what we have done wrong and created own stories); did *Tashliḥ* (symbolically “cast” away our burdens by throwing rocks into the pond)

Ask your child:

- What is the greeting we say to someone on *Yom Kippur*? (*ḥatimah tova*)
- What did you learn about Katie and Mr AG during their interviews?
- What is the word we use to say sorry? (*sliḥa*)
- What number is “1 ten and 3 ones”?
- What are the four things necessary for a habitat? (Food, Water, Shelter, and Air/Sunshine)
