This week, we

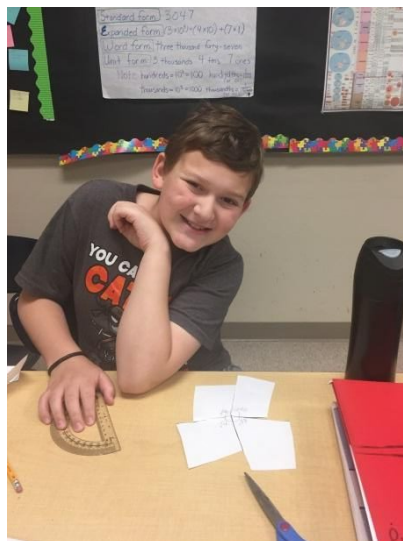
- Read from the Torah at School Tefillah! Each student chanted a verse or two. *Yashar Koah LeKhulam!*
- Completed our last round of Aimsweb testing.
- Learned about different quadrilaterals and how to measure their angles. (Ask your child to show you how to use a protractor.)
- Continued in Hebrew to explore the symbolism and history of flag design, in preparation for the creation of personal flags (*Re'im* group); made a video dramatizing a library book about the Israeli flag (*Yedidim* group).
- Finished the *City of Ember*. The students LOVED this book. If your child is interested in reading the next book in the series over the summer, it's called *The People of Sparks*.
- Wrote short *divrei Torah* for *Parashat Vayishlah*, raising a question on the text, examining different resolutions to the difficulty, and inferring a lesson from the inquiry.
- Started our last project, which is to create our own sustainable cities. The project integrates knowledge from language arts, social studies, and environmental science.
- Ran "Ten Commandments" relay races for Lag Ba'Omer. Ask your child which was most fun!
