We had a wonderful week of school! Some things we did were:

- Math-introduced subtraction including "taking away" and the minus sign.
- Science-talked about the habitat needs of a large variety of animals
- English-wrote in our journals about what we would bring on Noah's Ark
- Hebrew-learned the letter *hay* and *Ariot* came to deliver our new books!
- Judaics-learned about Noah's Ark (the *Torah* portion this week) by reading the traditional story, learning a fun Noah song, watching a video, and enjoying some rainbow *hallah* (this was Liav's sharing--thank you Rabbi Sharon!)
- Integration-read the story Why Noah Chose the Dove by Isaac Bashevis Singer, followed by a writing extension: which animal do you think Noah should choose and why?
- Lin-began learning about *kibbutzim*
- Jen-taught the class to follow "the group plan"

Ask your child:

- Which animal do you think Noah should have picked and why?
- What would you bring with you on the Ark?
- What is 6-1? (or say what is "one less" than 6)
- What did you say in our poem for Ariot?
- What is a *kibbutz*? (a community based on agriculture)
- Who is *Havhav*?
