This week, we:

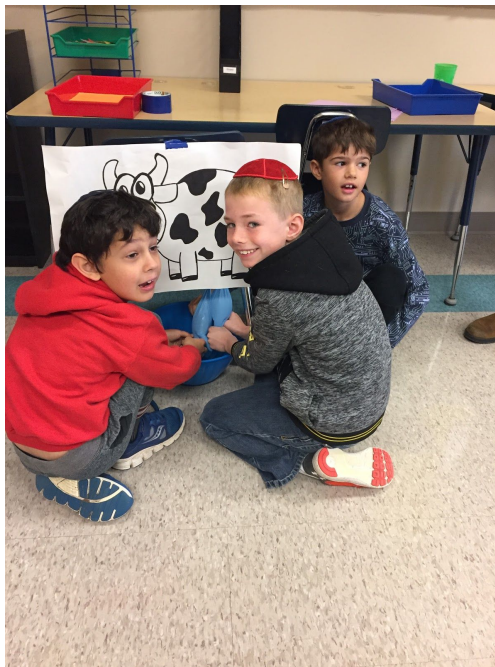
- Discussed what it means to be created "*B'tzelem Elohim*" - "In God's image", as it relates to the blessing we say in the morning thanking God for creating us in this way.
- Studied *Parashat Vayera*, focusing on the idea of welcoming guests, both those we plan for and those that are unexpected.
- Enjoyed a visit with our Shlichah, Lin, who created a "*kibbutz* experience" for us, including a station to milk a cow, check the eggs in the coop, and fold the laundry.
- Learned what an analogy is and used different types of analogies to demonstrate relationships between words.
- Created number lines using 1s, 10s, and 100s jumps to count from one number to another.
- Each researched a different planet, and then created our own planets that we would want to add to our solar system.
