6th Grade has had a busy week learning about Civil Rights and starting a new Math unit. We had a wonderful time celebrating Martin Luther King and Tu B'shvat with our senior friends at the Wexner Heritage Village. We are looking forward to welcoming Mr. Moc to our class on Monday.

- *Tefillah* : The students learned how to perform *hagba'ah*, lifting the Torah at the end of the Torah reading
- Math: We started a new unit exploring negative and positive integers.
- ELA: The students enjoyed writing 10 positive things they are committed to saying to others in 2019.
- Hebrew: Concluded our Tu B'Shvat textbook, *Eykh Natzil et Ha'Atzim* ? ( How Can We Save the Trees?) and created protest signs for our *hafganah*, demonstration against cutting down trees.
- *H umash*: Studied *perek* 40 about Yosef at the jail, interpreting the dreams of *Sar HaMashkim*, Pharaoh's chief cupbearer and *Sar HaOfim*, Pharaoh's chief baker.
- Social Studies: We continued our study of Civil Rights by learning new vocabulary and beginning to create a time line to depict events of the Civil Rights movement.
- Celebrated Tu B'shvat and Martin Luther King Day together with seniors at Creekside, with text study, followed by a Tu B'shvat seder.
- Celebrated *Hag Hasiddur* with our second grade buddies. They were amazing!





