We had a wonderful week of school! Some things we did were:

- Science-Continued investigating matter with bubbles (bubbles are gas/air trapped inside a liquid or solid) and danced in a bubble machine party
- English-Students learned about base words and the suffix -s to make a plural; reading groups read a variety of stories about bubbles, snowballs, and robots.
- Math-Created number lines and used them to make addition and subtraction easier
- Hebrew-learned the letter *lamed*, reviewed body parts in Hebrew
- Judaics-read a Hebrew story with *Hanukkah* riddles, played *Hanukkah*
- Related Arts - continued the roller unit in PE, read a *Hanukkah* story and illustrated their favorite parts from the book in Art, used boomwhackers in Music to learn about notes in a chord, and learned about composting with coffee in Environmental Ed
- Lin/Israel Ed - Students started to plan what will be part of their classroom *kibbutz*

- What happened in the story Emanuel and the Hanukkah Rescue (that you read in Art)?
