- Introduced journal writing in Hebrew; expanded our vocabulary of descriptive words for feelings.
- Learned the song, *Ufaratzta*, set to the words of God's promise in Ya'akov's dream, and explained their meaning on the map of Israel and through dance. Which sea, for example, is "to the sea", and what direction is meant?
