Abram "Abe" Weinrib said the secret to a long life is kindness. A Holocaust survivor, he passed away on January 4, 2015 at the age of 102. His gentle smile and positive outlook could often be found in the Diamond Family Fitness Center where he would work out and stay fit, well into his 90s. He visited with friends at the JCC every day, which kept him young and vibrant. His presence is still felt throughout the Center, where his youthful spirit lives on. We honor his memory and love of physical fitness with The Abe Weinrib Memorial 5K and 1-mile Family Fun Walk. 

WHO WE ARE

Mamanet is a fun, social sports league for mothers started in Israel 12 years ago and has been growing phenomenally around the world. It's been played in the U.S. for three years and at the Columbus JCC East for two years. The sport is Cachibol, also known as Newcomb, a variation of volleyball where players catch, pass and throw the ball using a regulation-size volleyball and court. Fun social events, team practices and games give women an opportunity to meet and bond with other women. Within the Mamanet community, women feel empowered and contribute their time and energy to projects that give back to their community.

Discrimination is painful, both to society and to the individuals enduring its harmful effects. In Israel, the fight for equality has long been taking place in the spheres of public law and political decision-making. Using the story of the Israeli Jews from Arab lands (Mizrahis) who have long been marginalized in Israel, the interesting new path of using civil claims for damages to obtain equality will be introduced.

In this 70 Faces of Israel discussion, Prof. Bitton will present her own perspective on this development, based on her experience as the legal scholar and as the activist who developed this pioneering legal advocacy tool, aimed at enhancing human rights protection in Israel.

Professor Yifat Bitton is a legal academic and social activist for equality specializing in anti-discrimination law and critical-egalitarian theory of law.

Bitton, an associate professor at Striks Law school in the College of Management and an Israel Institute visiting scholar at NYU, holds a Ph.D. from Hebrew University and an LL.M. from Yale University Law School, and spent a year as a Fulbright fellow at Harvard University Law School. She is the Co-founder and chair of "Tmura," The Israeli Clinical Centre for Equality.

For her long-lasting human rights work, Bitton has won myriad social and legal awards and prizes. Among them: The Alliance Prize for Education and Social Change; The Minister of Social Equality Award for Organizations Fighting Violence against Women; "Honoris Causa" Award of the Israeli Bar Association; The Safra Award for Excellence and Contribution to Israeli Society; The Hadassah Foundation Bernice Tennenbaum Prize for innovative feminist; The Human Rights Activist Award of The London Human Rights Annual Dinner and Dafna Israeli Fund's Prize for Israeli Feminist Leadership. Bitton was also Nominated Forbes' 50 Most Influential Women in Israel.
