This week the class took time to reflect on our Jewish Heroes unit. The students shared our thoughts regarding what they learned about their heroes and watched excerpts from the Living Museum and the All School Kabbalat Shabbat. The 6th grade was proud of the work they did, the lessons they learned, and the performances they shared with the school. We are looking forward to a restful winter break and know we will come back, ready to continue learning in 2019.

- Math: The class continued learning about the division algorithm in order to convert decimal division into whole number division using fractions.
- ELA: The students wrote paragraphs and drew analogies demonstrating their knowledge of the suffixes “ship” and “ous”.
- Hebrew: Completed stories in Hebrew for our book projects describing how each of us use our Thinking Hats in our daily lives or about our Living Museum Jewish hero.
- *Mishna*: We continued studying about cases in which two people claim ownership on the same item or the same animal. Students have developed understanding about the use of an oath in Jewish court.
- *Humash*: Concluded the unit about Yehudah and Tamar, discussed in which way each of them is a hero and reflected on what we can learn from the story that is relevant to our own life.
- Art: Even if we are far from Purim, students decorated *Mishloah Manot* bags to our friends in Kfar Saba. Eran will take the bags with him he will visit Brenner School over our Winter Break.

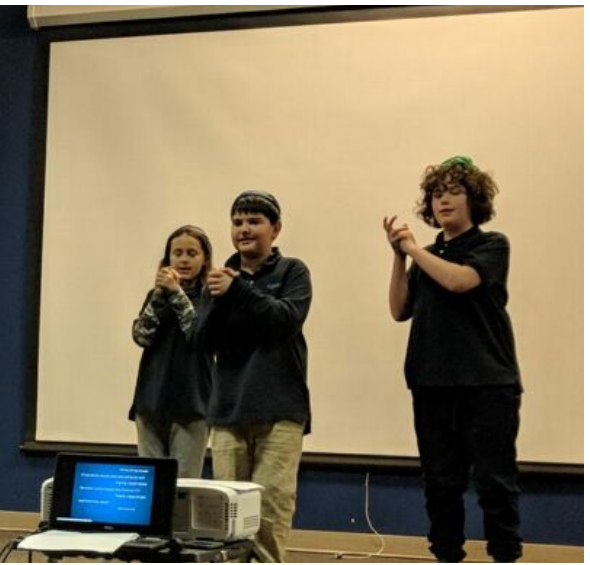

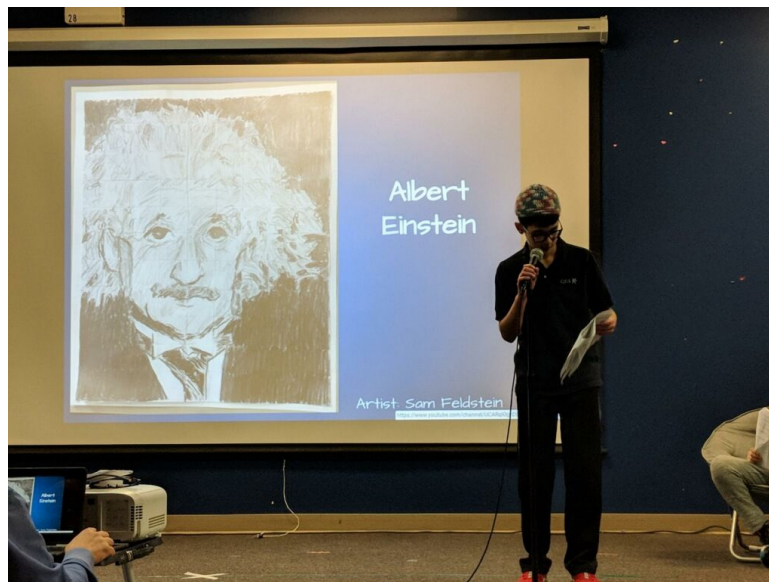
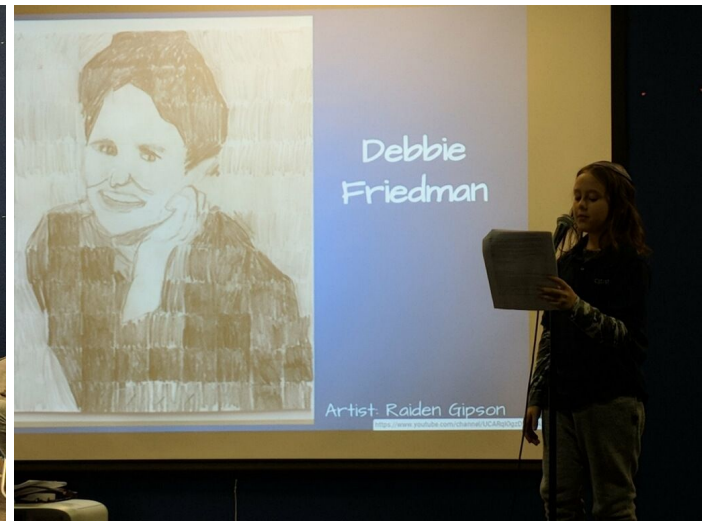
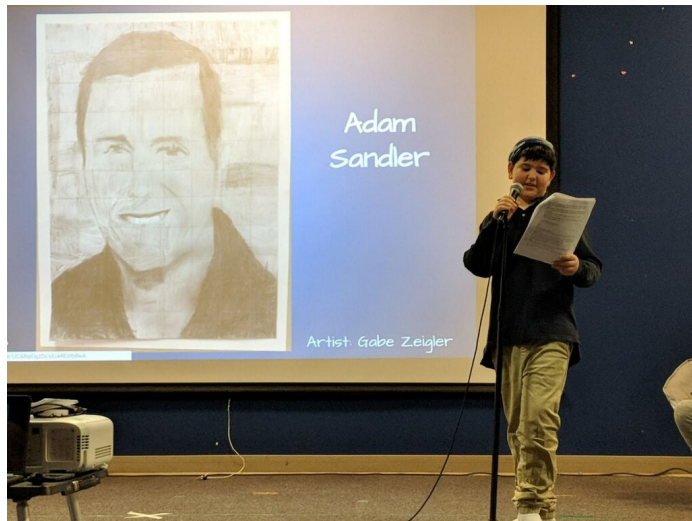
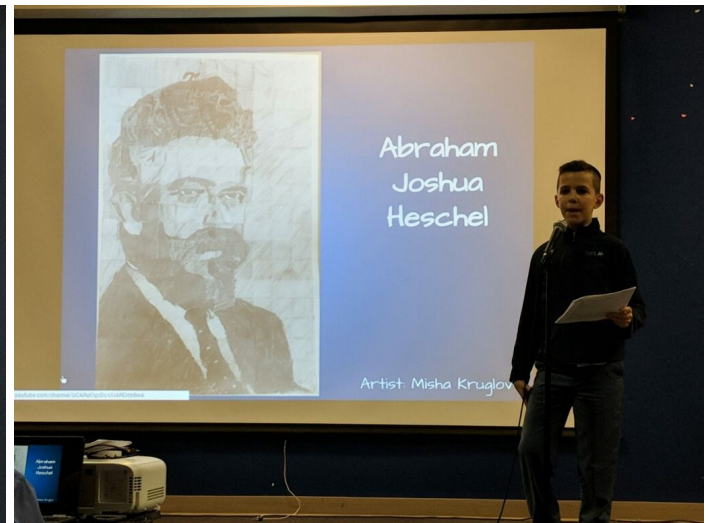
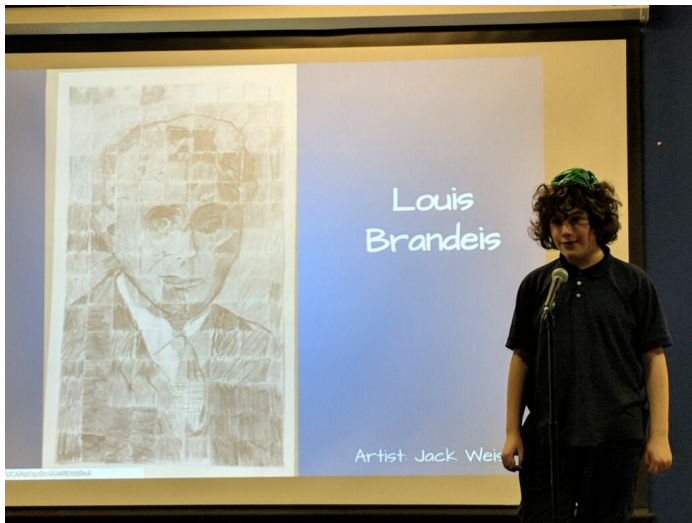
- What was your favorite part of our All School Kabbalat Shabbat?

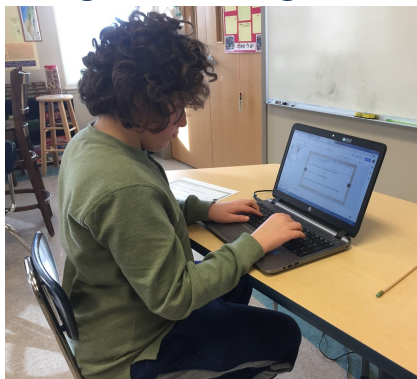
