We had a wonderful week of school! Some things we did were:

- Math-Practiced our speed and fluency to subtract numbers from 10
- English-Began our new unit about digraphs (wh, th, sh, ch, ck)
- Hebrew-Learned the letter *yud*
- Judaics- began learning about Hannukah: read the story of Hannukah in Hebrew
- Social Studies-Learned about the Wampanoag Tribe and Thanksgiving; drew Wampanoag symbols and made beaded bracelets
- Integration-Used Hebrew and English to learn body parts, play games, and prepare for Thanksgiving and Community Day

- What did *Ariot* bring to the children in *HaMorah Shira's* class? (yo-yo's)
- In the Hannukah story, what did the *Yevanim* (the Greeks) tell the *Yehudim* (the Jews) that they couldn't do? (speak Hebrew, study *Torah*, observe *Shabbat*)
- Practice subtraction from 10 (use fingers as an aid)
- What are the digraphs in the words "ship" and "chin"?
