This week, we

- Brainstormed what characteristics make a strong leader, translating that into images by drawing, "What does a leader look like?"

- Explored the concept of simile as we studied the Hebrew song, *Kol Shanah*. What does the song mean when it declares, "Every year begins with a question mark?"
- Wrote requests for the New Year, setting them aside in a bottle, to be sealed away until May.
- Reviewed multiplying and dividing decimals, and continued our work with exponents.
- Began a close reading of the first verses of *Parahsat Vayetzei*, and raised the following questions: What did Ya'akov do with the rocks he found in "the place", and why? What was "the place"? What were the angels in Ya'akov's dream doing on the ladder? To be continued...
