This week, we:

- Created the 8 phases of the moon using oreo cookies (see photos of our creations below)!
- Celebrated Hanukkah by lighting candles each morning, singing songs, creating our own edible dreidels, paper dreidels and playing the official dreidel game, and practicing using verbs for words connected to the holiday.
- Learned about Parashat Miketz, and talked about how we prepare when we know something bad is going to happen, like how Pharaoh was instructed to collect food in Egypt during his 7 plentiful years, in anticipation of his 7 bad years.
- Continued practicing addition with two-digit and three-digit numbers.
- Wrote narrative pieces in the spirit of Hanukkah about people in our lives who bring “light” to us.
