This week, we:

- Solved addition and subtraction word problems using the ruler as a number line.
- Discussed the components that make up narrative writing. Students then wrote narrative stories about a day when they came to CJDS and no teachers were at school!
- Reviewed the directions on a compass and discovered which direction they are facing when they are facing different places around CJDS.
- Learned about the mitzvah of being HAPPY on Sukkot and Simchat Torah, practiced shaking the lulav, and made our own flags to rejoice with the Torah celebration!
