This week:

- We have been reading stories to increase comprehension skills. This week, the students learned that some books are called non-fiction and they help to give us real information. Other books are called fiction and they are made up stories or fairy tales. Read a story to your child and ask if it is non-fiction (real) or fiction (made up).
- We practiced solving word problems, drawing in a 5 group way (ten frames) and writing number sentences.
- We learned why numbers 11-20 are written the way they are. For example, 11 is 1 ten and 1 one. Ask your child why these are numbers are written the way they are. Talk about tens and ones with them.
- We are beginning our Moshe/Pesach unit. We read the book Farfel, which really explains the life of a Hebrew slave. We generated a list of things that could not be taken away; love, family, friends, and hope...just to name a few.
- We took a close look at a pyramid. We asked ourselves how they could move these stones from 1 place to another. We wrote a journal entry answering the question..What did Egypt look like during the time of the Hebrew slaves?
