

What's New in Kindergarten?

This week:

- We have learned consonant digraphs: ch, wh sh, th and ck. We have been practicing sounding out and writing words with digraphs both at the beginning of a word and at the end of the word.
- We have continued our unit on Oceans. We have learned the 3 different zones of the ocean: sunlight, midnight, and twilight zone. We also have been introduced to many different types of animals in the ocean. The kindergarteners are partnered up to learn about one specific animal of their choice. They did some research of this animal in pairs. Ask your child what they learned about their animal.
- Last week, we used green and blue unifix cubes to cover our map of the world to see which has more, the ocean or land? All of the students predicted that the ocean would have more and they were right after counting all of the cubes by 10's.
- We painted the ocean with its different zones and created animals that belong in each zone.
- We had a visit from Dr. Tilson (Charlie's Grandpa!). He taught us about dental health and how to take care of our teeth for dental health month. Ask your child about Dr. Tilson's visit.
