Newton's Road Awarded an Impact100 Grant

We are thrilled to be awarded a 2020 [Impact100 Traverse City](#) grant for \$105,333 in support of our Community Liaison program. It is a great honor to be recognized for the impact of our work by this transformational group of women and we are grateful for the ability to expand our reach across the region.

Executive Director, Barb Termaat, states: "This grant helps Newton's Road to ensure ALL youth in our 5-county region have opportunities to spark their curiosity and instill a passion for learning that can last a lifetime. We live in a world that is dramatically changing--how we work, communicate and operate in a global space--and the jobs of the future are evolving. We are helping to nurture a STEM culture, one that promotes and invests in creative problem solving, to prepare our youth for the careers of the future, locally and globally."



Library of Michigan Grant with TADL

The Traverse Area District Library (TADL) and Newton's Road received a \$14,000 grant to increase the number of STEM kits available for hands-on learning at home. This joint effort will translate into 200+ additional STEM kits available to students at libraries throughout the 5-county region. The grant was a Library Services and Technology Act grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services, administered by the Library of Michigan.



3D Printer for the Elk Rapids Native American Program

The Elk Rapids Rotary Youth Services team and Newton's Road Executive Director Barb Termaat delivered a 3D printer to the Elk Rapids Schools Native American program this month. The goal is for the teachers and students in the program to become 3D printing skills experts for the district and community. We are excited to see what the teachers and students will create!




STEM for Students and Parents


Connections for Educators
