FAMA Bible Study

FAMA stands for Facts, Association, Meaning and Action.

FACTS: Reflect and discuss what was done or seen in the reading.

ASSOCIATION: Connect the experience to your own feelings and lives.

MEANING: Identify and discuss the deeper meaning of the experience, and its importance.

ACTION: Invite people to take action.

John 21:6-8

6 He said to them, “Cast the net to the right side of the boat, and you will find some.” So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in because there were so many fish. 7 That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, “It is the Lord!” When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on some clothes, for he was naked, and jumped into the sea. 8 But the other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, only about a hundred yards^{or} off.
