

St. Martin's-in-the-Field Episcopal Church in Severna Park, Md. seeks a talented organist with a heart for mentoring musicians in a growing congregation as a half-time Director of Music/Organist starting January 1, 2017. The incumbent will work with the rector to coordinate all music for a single Sunday service of about 225 people, including hymns, service music, prelude and postludes as well as special services as needed. The Director of Music will also be responsible for directing one adult choir and one children's choir (currently with about 20 and 6 members respectively), with one weekly rehearsal for each group. The church has a Schantz 29-rank instrument with 3 divisions and 27 stops installed in 2008, a Yamaha 6-foot piano fully restored in 2014, a full set of handbells and an extensive music library. Annual budget for worship (including altar supplies and instrument repair) is \$5000. Salary commensurate with experience according to American Guild of Organist and Association of Anglican Musicians guidelines. Minimum qualification of a Bachelors degree/CAGO or 5 years experience. Position includes 2 weeks paid vacation. Potential for increase in both compensation and responsibilities exists in future years.
