

The Music Program at Saint Luke's, Darien, CT, is currently accepting applications for the position of Organ Scholar/Music Associate to begin on or before Sept. 1, 2017.

Ideally suited for a student in the NYC metro area or along Metro-North's New Haven line, the position offers a stipend of \$10K per year with a rent and utility-free, one-bedroom furnished apartment on the Saint Luke's campus (laundry facilities included). The apartment is available year-round or may be used as a weekend/summer residence and is located a short walk from the beach. A monthly rail pass is offered if a student requires train access, and use of church facilities is available for private teaching, if desired. The opportunity for additional compensation by playing for funerals and weddings comes along often.

Responsibilities include weekly Sunday morning service playing (two morning services), divided between the Director of Music and Organ Scholar; Thursday evening rehearsals; monthly Saturday Evensong; rehearsing and conducting opportunities; working with, as schedules allow, the young voices of the Primary/Junior/Senior Choirs which utilize the RSCM's *Voice for Life* training curriculum. It also affords the unique opportunity to be a vital part of a large program-sized church, (Saint Luke's is the largest Episcopal parish in CT and the second-largest in New England).

Saint Luke's is located 2 minutes off I-95 and less than 5 minutes from two Metro-North stations. Darien is less than an hour train from Grand Central Station or New Haven's Union Station.
