

In collaboration with partners, Vermont is updating the Missisquoi Bay Tactical Basin Plan. The water quality and habitat management plan identifies rivers, lakes and wetlands in need of restoration and protection. It also outlines actions to achieve water quality goals and identifies partners and funding critical to implementing the actions. The plan will be released at the end of 2026.
