

The WFB Farmers Market is happy to say we are open for business starting July 11th. We are working to provide as much space as possible for vendors and for customers to shop safely. Following State Guidelines, the WFB Market will be enforcing these at our Saturday Market and as we move forward, those guidelines will be updated as needed. Wear a mask. Be mindful of those around you. Maintain social distancing, and unlike how you may be accustomed to shopping, leave the reusable bags at home. See you at the Market July 11th – August 8 in the St. Monica's Parking Lot off of Lake View Ave, then August 15th – October 19th Dominican High School Parking Lot on Bay Ridge Avenue.

WFB Farmers Market guidelines for customers:

- Stay home if you are sick or you are in a high-risk group
- Face coverings are recommended to be worn while shopping
- Practice good cough and hand hygiene. Sanitization Station will be set up at the Market for regular use by customers and vendors.
- Maintain 6-foot distancing from other customers and vendors while walking around market and while making or waiting to make purchases or at Info Booth
- Customers age 65+ should have someone shop for them whenever possible
- Listen to WFB Market Manager and Vendors who will communicate with and disperse customers if physical distancing is not being practiced; one customer per vendor's marked selling area will be allowed
- Customers are discouraged from handling produce/products before buying; vendor encouraged to bag/pack purchases
- Reusable shopping bags are discouraged.
- When exchanging paper and coin money:
 - Do not touch your face afterward.
 - Place money directly on counter when paying, and change will be placed directly on counter as well.
 - Vendor will wipe down counter between each customer at checkout.
- Make a shopping list and complete shopping as quickly as possible
- Strongly recommend one customer per household to enter the market for shopping.
- Continue to support the WFB Farmers Market vendors! They rely on your patronage and are doing everything possible to adhere to health guidelines for your safety. Please be kind and patient with our vendors and staff. Remember this is not social hour! Limit interactions with other customers, vendors and staff.
