ACCEPTED

Glass Bottles and Jars (rinsed)

- All colors
- Please rinse
- No need to remove labels
- Bottle caps and metal lids

Aluminum Cans

- May be crushed

Aluminum Foil – unused/no food residue

Tin/Steel/Bi-Metal Cans

- May be crushed

Plastic

- HDPE Plastic milk and water jugs
- PET plastic containers including 1-2-3 liter pop bottles
- Plastics #1 through #7
- Soda bottles
- Laundry bottles
- Shampoo, conditioner, lotion and cosmetic bottles

Paper

- Brown grocery bags
- Business envelopes, forms
- Construction paper
- Copy/computer/fax paper
- Window type envelopes
- File folders
- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Newspaper
- Telephone books, paperback books

Cardboard

- Beverage Carriers
- Cereal/cake mix/ detergent/beverage boxes
- Corrugated - flatten to maximize space
- Egg cartons (paper or clear plastic)
- Paper Towel and Toilet paper tubes
- Tissue Boxes (empty)

NOT ACCEPTED

The following items are not recyclable by the Whitefish Bay Recycling Program at this time:

- Auto/Mirror and Tinted Glass
- Blueprints/Overhead transparencies
- Car parts, nails and screws
- Carpet
- Carbon paper
- Ceramic items (dishes, vases, cups)
- Clothing
- Crystal type materials or beverage glasses
- Disposable Diapers
- Drinking glasses or crystal
- Food or food-soiled paper, cardboard, metal
- Flower plastic cartons and temporary holders
- Frozen food boxes
- Gasoline cans and scrap metal
- Glass Pyrex
- Hazardous waste or containers
- Lids and caps of plastic bottles
- Light bulbs
- Medical supplies
- Milk, dairy, juice cartons-waxed or paper
- Motor oil and antifreeze bottles
- Paper towels, napkins or facial tissue
- Paper contaminated with food residue
- Pesticide and herbicide containers
- Pet-soiled paper
- Photography or Photographic paper
- Pizza boxes or carryout food wrappers or foil
- Plastic Bags of any kind
- Plastic toys, flower pots or garden plastics
- Pots and pans
- Rubber type materials or latex
- Plastic Bags
- Self-adhesive labels
- Styrofoam egg cartons, microwave containers
- Tissues, tissue products and paper towel
- Wrapping paper
- Yard Waste
