Project Update

On April 24, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will begin Stage 1 of reconstructing the Green Tree Road Bridge over I-43. The existing bridge, constructed in 1961, is scheduled for a full replacement.

During this stage, the Good Hope Road entrance ramp to I-43 southbound will be reconstructed, storm sewer work will take place along I-43, and adjustments to Green Tree Road and Jean Nicolet Road will be made to match the new bridge profile.

Stage 1 Traffic Impacts *(starting the week of April 24)*

- 90-day closure of Good Hope Road entrance ramp to I-43 southbound begins in Early May.
- Overnight single lane and full freeway closures for storm sewer work.
- Closure of Green Tree Road west of Jean Nicolet Road.
- Westbound Green Tree Road access to southbound Jean Nicolet Road only.


Detour

For both the ramp closure and overnight freeway closures, motorists should use Good Hope Road, WIS 57 (Green Bay Road), and Silver Spring Drive to connect back with I-43 in either direction.
