



Senator Lee Heider is serving his ninth year in Idaho Legislature. For the past eight years, he has served in the Senate's Health and Welfare Committee with six years as Chairman. Concurrently, the Senator has served on the Senate's committee for Resources and Environment. Currently, Senator Heider serves as Chairman of the Resources and Environment Committee.

During the past eight years, Senator Heider also served on the Pacific Fisheries Task Force and recently received a Gubernatorial Appointment to serve on the Pacific States Marine Fisheries Commission.

Senator Heider has served on policy committees for both, the Pacific Northwest Economic Region (PNWER) and CSG WEST, including Chairman of CSG WEST's Legislative Council on River Governance. In this capacity, he has been very active on water issues. Two issues, in particular, are of importance to him: border security between states against the spreading of Invasive Species; and the renewal or extension of The Columbia River Treaty. Senator Heider is very engaged in, and enjoys, the relationships he has fostered with both PNWER and CSG WEST.
