

RULES / HOW TO SUBMIT:

DROP OFF: Vashon Heritage Museum, 10105 SW Bank Road, 1–4 p.m., Wednesday–Sunday

- Open to all 4th- and 5th-grade students (public, private, or home-school) OR students ages 9–11
- A small group may collaborate on a project
- Every project must include a written piece explaining why you chose this project and why you felt it was important; additional information to include might be, for example: image captions, a list of interview questions, a written interpretation for a dance, and so on.
- You may submit your entry on a CD, DVD, USB flash drive, or via email; **DO NOT USE YOUTUBE**
- Photographs must be 300 dpi; essays and other written material may be submitted as a .doc, .docx, or .pdf file
- Entries must be submitted either in person at the museum, electronically by email, or postmarked by U.S. Mail no later than April 3, 2020
- Please submit only one entry
- Your entry must have been created after December 31, 2019
- A video must be under three (3) minutes in length; a written submission must be no longer than five (5) pages
- Make sure you use only content you have permission to use; your entry must not infringe on any third-party copyright or trademark or violate the rights of any person or entity
- Your entry may not contain images of or quotes by any individuals who have not given you permission to use them; if owned by anyone under the age of 21, parents or guardians must give permission
- The project must be the original work of the student and carry permission to use any copyrighted or quoted material; cite all quoted materials
- All entries must be appropriate for viewing by the general public; appropriateness will be determined by the VMIHA Education Committee
- The entry must include, **ON A SEPARATE PAGE FROM THE PROJECT ITSELF:**
 - A. Project title
 - B. Your full name
 - C. Your contact information (email, telephone number, mailing address)
 - D. A parent or guardian's first and last name

- A panel of judges will review submissions
- Winners will be notified via email or phone by April 17, 2020

PRIZE DESCRIPTION

- All entrants will receive a one-year student membership in the Vashon-Maury Island Heritage Association
- All entrants will receive a Certificate of Recognition, and a celebration will be held for all participants
- Top entrants may receive a monetary prize; at the judges' discretion, prizes may be awarded in the amounts of \$100, \$50, and \$25

Each submission remains the property of the entrant, but submitting an entry constitutes the entrant's permission for the Vashon Heritage Museum to use, reproduce, adapt, publish, and display any or all submissions.
