ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a Montgomery County resident who lives in the Laytonsville Lions Club Foundation's general service area and is a student or a graduate of Gaithersburg High School or Damascus High School.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. Demonstrated exemplary service to the community during this pandemic by volunteering at a not-for-profit facility.
- 2. Financial need and if you have applied for other financial scholarship or aid.
- 3. GPA of at least 2.5
- 4. References from teachers, faith-based or not-for-profit facility, supervisors at facility where you volunteered.
- 5. Field of study
- 6. A brief description describing what your volunteer activity has accomplished and what you have learned from the experience.
- 7. Provide a brief description describing how this scholarship will assist you in reaching your future goals.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE
