



## League of Women Voters Primary Election *Voters' Guide* 2020 is Here!

The 2020 *Voters' Guide* provides information on voting changes due to the COVID-19 pandemic, as well as candidates' responses, in their own words, to questions on a variety of issues. Use the *Voters' Guide* to assist you in your decision-making process as you vote by mail in the Primary Election. Upon completion, your ballot must be post marked on or before June 2 or returned at a secure ballot drop off box at any of four Vote Centers, the Board of Elections or Rockville City Hall from May 21 to June 2.

The Primary Election will include voting for candidates for President of the United States, U.S. House of Representatives, Judge of the Circuit Court and Board of Education and Delegates to the National Political Party Conventions.

This year, for the first time, the League has also published the full *Voters' Guide* in Spanish.
