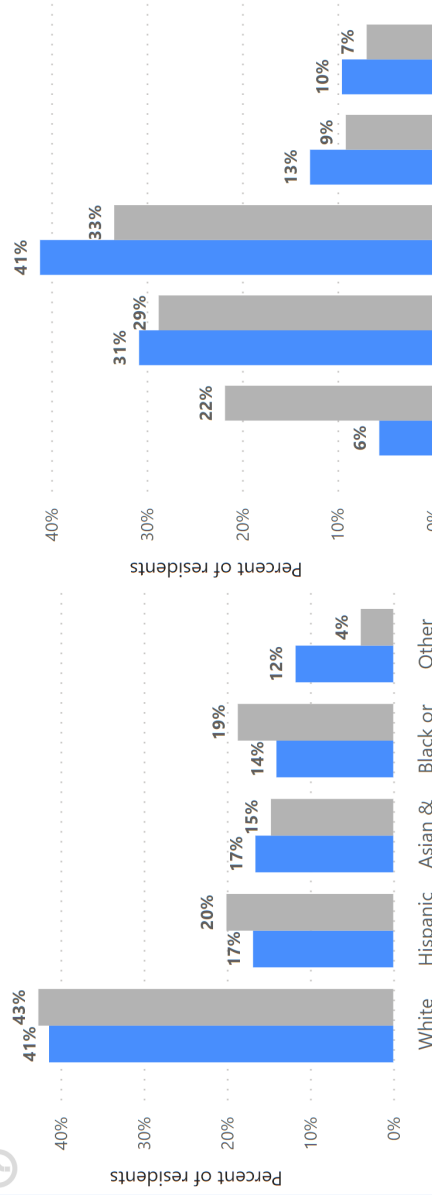

Percent of unique residents that have received a vaccine by the top four most populous races and ethnicities

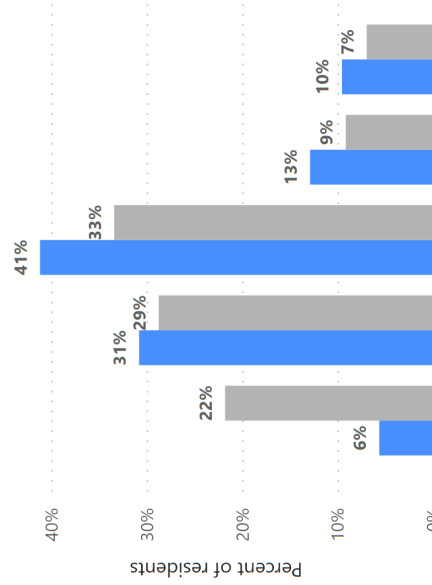

Age of residents who have received a vaccine

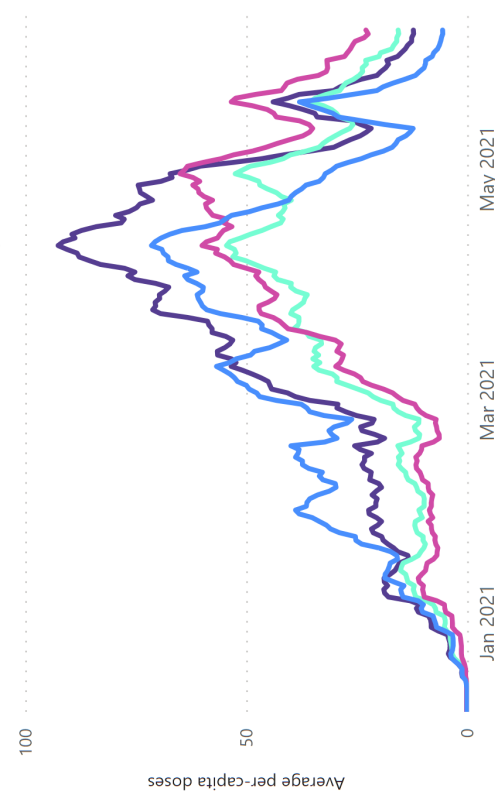
Percent of unique residents that have received a vaccine by the top four most populous races and ethnicities
