Alaska's weather varies throughout the year and often, throughout the day. The more prepared you are, the more you'll be able to appreciate "The Last Frontier." Instead of heavy winter coats, think instead of waterproof, re-movable articles that you can add and remove with ease. Here are some simple packing suggestions for your cruise:

CLOTHING:

- Casual dinner outfits
- Comfy sweaters
- Formal wear for cruise nights; cocktail dress or suit and tie
- Jeans/leggings/slacks
- Rain hat and a wool hat
- Scarves (fleece)
- Shorts
- Socks (think wool)
- Sunglasses (with polarized lenses)
- Swimsuit
- Touchscreen gloves
- T-shirts and long-sleeve shirts
- Vest or windbreaker (for when on deck)
- Warm hoodie
- Waterproof jacket (for layering)

SHOES:

- Two pairs of waterproof/ mud shoes or boots (comfy w/extra support)
- Casual shoes
- Dress shoes
- Flip-flops/water shoes

MISCELLANEOUS:

- Toiletries
- Prescription meds and backup eyeglasses/contacts (just in case)
- Phone chargers/USB converters
- Binoculars (for viewing wildlife)
- Telephoto camera with extra memory cards
- Passports
- Small daypack (for excursions and souvenirs)
- Nausea relief
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent (it may be surprising: Alaska has plenty of mosquitoes!)
