



MISSION STATEMENT OF NAZARETH PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

To worship and glorify God and to make disciples for Christ.

Dear Nazareth Family,

If I had to use one word to describe Nazareth in May, 2022 it would be "Celebrate!" Within this month we will celebrate turning 250 years old but also welcome our newest confirmands on May 8. We will celebrate new beginnings as we baptize one of our youth and honor our College and High School graduates but also remember our past by worshiping in the cemetery on Memorial Day Sunday. Therefore, don't miss ONE WORD of this month's Meeting House News! It may be the only way to keep it straight!

Recently, I was interviewed by a staff member of the "Spartanburg Herald Journal." Assuming he cannot print everything that I offered, I wanted to share some of what I told him as a way of letting you know how blessed I am to be the pastor here.

How do you feel about being the current minister in a long line of noted and distinguished ministers?

It is an honor and a privilege to serve this congregation. They are the most wonderful, caring group of people that I have ever served. The ways that this congregation reaches out to each other, the community and the world, is truly amazing! They are well-known as being a healthy and service-oriented congregation in the Foothills Presbytery, which is a result of successful past leadership. It is a privilege to be a part of this legacy. I am also honored to be the first female Installed Head of Staff.

What will non-church members find surprising about Nazareth Presbyterian Church?

How wonderful our music is, especially for a church of 230 members. Also, how much we contribute to missions – locally, nationally, and worldwide. We sent 17 youth and 4 adults on a summer mission to inner-city Charlotte last summer and are sending a larger group of youth this summer to work in Appalachia. We helped establish The Carpenter's Table, to serve the hungry on the West side of Spartanburg. I think many people assume our church is small with few young people, which is a myth. We have people of all ages who are very active.

I am looking forward to every event that we spend together, now and in the future.


