TAKE THE NEXT STEP

Our business partnerships, volunteers, and donors allow Take the Next Step to transform the struggling neighborhoods in Monroe like the Sky River apartment area, the area around TTNS, the neighborhoods off of Blueberry Lane and Killarney Circle. Our Kidz Club focuses on these neighborhoods to get these kids up to grade level in their reading and math. We combat the effects of adverse childhood experiences ("ACE's") by creating meaningful and stable relationships with adults. And we create indigenous leaders in these neighborhoods with Kidz Club's partnership with Youth for Christ- so our kids have the same leaders walking with them kindergarten - high school.

Their support gets kids school clothes and supplies. It feeds our hungry neighbors sack lunches and pantry packs for the weekend, and at our Community Dinners. It allows us to facilitate Job-Readiness classes to get the unemployed but able in our community, back into the workforce, and back to being productive members of our city and society. It also supports the young moms in Sky

Valley to live happy and healthy, productive lives while bringing up healthy and happy children. Take the Next Step is also participating in meetings with our community partners to strategically tackle the up rise of homelessness in our valley.

78% of homeless families in Snohomish County are headed by a single mom. A two-bedroom apartment at Morningrun Apartments goes for about \$1,100/ month. To be able to afford this apartment working a minimum wage job, she'd have to work about 97 hours/week. We have these high-poverty areas in Monroe and children living in these areas, attend a high-poverty school, and are 7x more likely to drop out

of school than other children. Our valley needs a place like Take the Next Step to fill these gaps, catch these children, and give families a chance to catch up- to take their next steps!

Jan-June 2016 our Drop-in Center had about 2,400 visits- 49% of those visitors were homeless. In May of this year, we saw nearly 500 visitors, of which 68% were homeless. Last year with our sack lunches and community dinners we served about 12,000




